A COPY OF THESE 2011 LEAGUE RULES ARE ONLY ACCEPTABLE FOR REFERENCE DURING A GAME.

THE LEAGUE RULES (LISTED BELOW) ARE TO BE FOLLOWED AT ALL TIMES. THE SUGGESTED PARK GROUND RULES ARE TO BE FOLLOWED. HOWEVER, IF BOTH TEAM CAPTAINS' WANT TO USE ANY MODIFICATION, THEY MUST BE DISCUSSED AND DECIDED UPON BY EACH TEAM CAPTAIN AND THE UMPIRE AT THE PRE-GAME MEETING. IF BOTH TEAMS CANNOT AGREE, THE UMPIRE WILL MAKE THE FINAL DECISION.

THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THIS LEAGUE IS TO PROVIDE A FUN, ENJOYABLE AND WELL-ORGANIZED ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS. EVERY RULE AND REGULATION THAT FOLLOWS IS DESIGNED TO MEET THIS PURPOSE.

A. PLAYING RULES

SCORING PLATE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• (PLACED A MINIMUM SIX FEET AWAY FROM HOME PLATE IN FOUL TERRITORY) - USED ONLY BY THE BASE RUNNER TO SCORE A RUN• THE BASE RUNNER IS IN-JEOPARDY IF THEY FAIL TO TOUCH THE SCORING PLATE• NO SLIDING; INTENTIONALLY DIVING; OR FLOPPING ON TOP OF THE SCORING PLATE (OTHERWISE, RUNNER WILL BE CALLED OUT)• IN THE EVENT OF INCLIMATE WEATHER - THE UMPIRE WILL DECIDE TO KEEP USING THE SCORING PLATE, OR TO REVERT TO A SCORING LINE
HOME PLATE:	A BASE RUNNER IS CALLED OUT IF THEY TOUCH HOME PLATE (FOR ANY REASON)
HOME AND AWAY TEAMS (ARRIVE AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULED GAME START TIME):	<p>AS PER SCHEDULE; HOME TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• OPENING THE FENCE GATES (BURNABY NORTH LOCATION); OPEN UP THE EQUIPMENT BOX TO TAKING OUT ALL BASES, CONES, HOME PLATE, DIG-OUT TOOL AND SCORING PLATE; SECURING ALL EQUIPMENT PROPERLY IN ITS CORRECT LOCATION ON THE FIELD; OPENING THE LIGHT BOX, ACTIVATING THE FIELD LIGHTS, AND LOCK UP THE LIGHT BOX (BURNABY NORTH AND SQUINT LAKE PARK LOCATIONS). PLACE DIG-OUT TOOL, BOTH KEY LOCKS, AND ALL BASE PLUGS INSIDE EQUIPMENT BOX. <p>HOME PLATES IN BURNABY ARE PERMANENTLY SET INTO THE GROUND.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• PROVIDE THE TWO GAME BALLS (ONE IS NEW AND THE OTHER IS A BACKUP IN GOOD CONDITION)• RAKING THE INFIELDF AND BATTER'S AREAS AT HOME PLATE• TAKING AWAY ALL BASES, CONES, HOME PLATE, AND SCORING PLATE FROM THE FIELD; PUT AWAY ALL EQUIPMENT INSIDE THE EQUIPMENT STORAGE BOX; INSERT ALL BASE PLUGS INTO GROUND INSERTS – THEN COVERING OVER WITH SAND SO THEY ARE NOT SEEN; CLOSE EQUIPMENT BOX LID AND CLOSE BOTH LOCKS (THEY MUST ALL BE LOCKED) <p>TEAM CAPTAINS' FROM BOTH TEAMS MUST HAVE THEIR EQUIPMENT STORAGE BOX AND LIGHT BOX KEYS IN THEIR POSSESSION FOR ALL THEIR GAMES</p>
SCORING COMMITMENT LINE:	<p>DRAWN TWENTY FEET FROM THE CORNER OF HOME PLATE CLOSEST TO THIRD BASE AND PERPENDICULAR TO THE THIRD BASE LINE (EXTENDS FROM THE BASE LINE TO THE BACKSTOP FENCE), AND INDICATED BY A SAFETY CONE PLACE FLUSH AT THE LINE AND THE BACKSTOP.</p> <p>IF THE BASE RUNNER TOUCHES OR CROSSES THIS LINE, THEY HAVE COMMITTED TO SCORE. A</p>

SCORING COMMITMENT LINE: (CONT'D.)	DEFENSIVE PLAYER MAY TAG A BASE RUNNER (BEFORE OR AFTER) THE RUNNER CROSSES THIS LINE. IF A DEFENSIVE PLAYER OBSTRUCTS A BASE RUNNER DURING THE ACT OF ATTEMPTING TO SCORE A RUN, THE BASE RUNNER WILL BE CALLED SAFE (SPN OBSTRUCTION RULE IN EFFECT). REVISED FOR 2011 SEASON
THIRD-STRIKE OUT:	(FOUL-OUT, MISSING, OR LOOKING). THE REGULAR STRIKE ZONE IS USED (NO STRIKE MAT)
NO BUNTING:	BATTER WILL BE CALLED OUT
NO LEAD-OFFS:	ONLY BASE-RUNNER ANTICIPATION IS PERMITTED (PER SPN RULEBOOK GUIDELINES)
NO OUTFIELD ENCROACHMENT LINE:	THE OUTFIELD AREAS ARE WIDE-OPEN. ALL BASERUNNERS ARE IN JEOPARDY TO BE PUT OUT AT ALL TIMES, AND AT ANY BASE.
FEMALE BATTER/RUNNER CANNOT BE THROWN OUT DIRECTLY FROM OUTFIELD WHILE RUNNING TOWARDS FIRST BASE:	A FEMALE BATTER/RUNNER CANNOT BE THROWN OUT AT FIRST BASE FROM A DIRECT OUTFIELD THROW WHILE RUNNING TOWARDS FIRST BASE (THE OUTFIELDER MUST THROW TO AN INFIELDER, WHO CAN THROW TO FIRST BASE). DEFENSIVE PENALTY: IF NOT DONE SO: THE BATTER/RUNNER WILL BE CALLED SAFE. NEW FOR 2011 SEASON
DEFENSIVE PLAYER POSITIONING:	DEFENSIVE PLAYER MUST STAND A MINIMUM OF 50 FEET, FROM THE FRONT OF HOME PLATE (IN FAIR TERRITORY), AS EACH PITCH IS DELIVERED – ONLY ALLOWED TO MOVE INWARDS ONLY WHEN CONTACT WITH THE BALL HAS BEEN MADE
PITCHING ZONE:	24 INCHES WIDE, LOCATED BETWEEN 50 AND 65 FEET AWAY FROM HOME PLATE
MODIFIED BC 9 CO-ED RULE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TEAMS MUST START A GAME WITH A MINIMUM NINE PLAYERS AT THE OFFICIAL GAME START TIME, WHERE A MINIMUM OF THREE FEMALES MUST BE PRESENT TEAMS ARE ALLOWED TO ADD A TENTH PLAYER TO THE BATTING ORDER AT ANY TIME AFTER THE GAME START (ONLY IF THE PLAYER WAS LISTED ON THEIR LINE-UP CARD AS A SUBSTITUTE OR STARTER) PRIOR TO THE OFFICIAL GAME START TIME (DUE TO INJURY): A TEAM UNABLE TO FIELD A TENTH PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPLETE THAT GAME WITH THE NINE REMAINING PLAYERS, BUT THEIR MISSING POSITION MUST BE RECORDED AS AN AUTO-OUT. A PLAYER REMOVED FROM THE GAME (DUE TO INJURY) IS INELIGIBLE TO RE-ENTER THE GAME AT ANY SUBSEQUENT TIME. THE PLAYER'S POSITION SHALL BE RECORDED AS AN AUTO-OUT FOR EVERY TIME THE PLAYER WAS DUE TO BAT. <p>(DUE TO PLAYER EJECTION TO OFFENDING TEAM): AN OFFENDING TEAM HAVING A PLAYER(S) EJECTED FROM A GAME RESULTING WITH LESS THAN TEN PLAYERS WILL FORFEIT THE GAME TO THE OPPOSING TEAM [i.e. NO SUBSTITUTIONS ALLOWED FOR ANY EJECTED PLAYER(S)]. IF A NON-OFFENDING TEAM DROPS BELOW NINE PLAYERS AS A RESULT OF AN INJURY CAUSED BY AN OFFENDING TEAM'S PLAYER EJECTION, THE OFFENDING TEAM WILL FORFEIT THE GAME. REVISED FOR 2011 SEASON</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> TEAMS HAVING LESS THAN NINE PLAYERS TO START OR COMPLETE A GAME WILL FORFEIT THE GAME TO THE OPPOSING TEAM, AFTER THE GRACE TIME PERIOD HAS EXPIRED. AN AUTOMATIC OUT IS RECORDED WHERE A MISSING PLAYER WOULD HAVE BATTED (EITHER THE 9TH OR 10TH BATTING POSITION).
NO-JEWELRY RULE (EXCEPT FOR MEDIC-ALERT BRACELETS) - ALWAYS IN EFFECT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> EXAMPLES INCLUDE: ANY TYPE OF EARRINGS; NOSE STUDS; NOSE RINGS; BELLY-BUTTON RINGS; EYEBROW RINGS, ETC. IF JEWELRY ITEM(S) CAN'T BE REMOVED, ITEMS MAY BE SECURELY TAPED OR COVERED. IF ANY INJURY RESULTS FROM THIS RULING, AN INSURANCE CLAIM MAY BE DEEMED NULL AND VOID. <p>(FIRST OCCURRENCE - REFERS TO THE 2011 SPN B.C. POLICY, WHICH SUPERCEDES THE RULE INDICATED IN THE 2011 SPN RULE BOOK): THE UMPIRE WILL ISSUE A VERBAL WARNING TO BOTH TEAMS. AND WILL ANNOUNCE THAT THE NEXT OCCURRENCE WILL RESULT IN THE OFFENDED PLAYER BEING CALLED OUT. ANY PLAYER WHO REFUSES TO REMOVE THEIR</p>

NO-JEWELRY RULE - ALWAYS IN EFFECT: (CONT'D.)	JEWELRY ITEM (WHEN REQUESTED TO BY THE UMPIRE) WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EJECTED FROM THE GAME.
NO-BLOOD; NO-PROFANITY; PREGNANCY RULES:	ARE ALWAYS IN EFFECT (NO EXCEPTIONS) – PER SPN RULEBOOK GUIDELINES
GAME TIME LENGTHS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SINGLE GAMES: 90-MINUTE MAX.TIME LIMIT (NO NEW INNING MAY START AFTER 80 MINUTES) • DOUBLE-HEADERS AND MULTI-HEADERS: 75-MINUTE MAX. TIME LIMIT (NO NEW INNING MAY START AFTER 65 MINUTES)
GAMES WILL END (WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST) BY EITHER:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MERCY RULE • GAME CALLED, DUE TO DARKNESS • GAME CALLED, DUE TO UNSAFE FIELD CONDITIONS • GAME CALLED, DUE TO INCLIMATE WEATHER • AFTER SEVEN COMPLETED INNINGS. IF TIE, REFER TO 'TIEBREAKER RULE' BELOW. • TEAM HAVING LESS THAN MINIMAL AMOUNT OF PLAYERS (REFER TO MODIFIED BC NINE RULE ABOVE)
GRACE TIME: REVISED FOR 2011 SEASON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MAXIMUM OF TEN MINUTES, IF A TEAM HAVING LESS THAN NINE PLAYERS AT START OF GAME TIME • GRACE TIME IS DEDUCTED FROM THE SCHEDULED GAME TIME SLOT (NO EXTRA TIME IS ADDED ONTO THE ALLOTTED GAME TIME LENGTH) • FROM SCHEDULED GAME START TIME UNTIL GRACE TIME IS LESS THAN FIVE MINUTES: TEAM (CAUSING THE DELAY) IS PENALIZED WITH A THREE-RUN DEFICIT. GAME STARTS AT THE FIRST INNING. • FROM BETWEEN FIVE AND TEN MINUTES OF GRACE TIME: TEAM (CAUSING THE DELAY) IS PENALIZED WITH A FIVE-RUN DEFICIT. GAME STARTS AT THE SECOND INNING.
MERCY RULE:	A TEAM AHEAD BY A SCORE OF 12 RUNS OR MORE. ANYTIME (AFTER 5 OR MORE COMPLETED INNINGS, 4 1/2 INNINGS IF THE HOME TEAM IS LEADING), THE GAME IS DECLARED OVER
WARM-UP PERIOD:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO INFIELD OR OUTFIELD WARM-UP BALLS IN THE FIELD AFTER THE FIRST INNING OF A GAME • ALL PLAYERS MUST HUSTLE ON/ OFF THE FIELD BETWEEN INNINGS AT ALL TIMES IN A TIMELY MANNER, IN ORDER TO PLAY AS MANY INNINGS POSSIBLE
TIEBREAKER RULE:	AFTER THE COMPLETION OF SEVEN FULL INNINGS (ONLY IF TIME PERMITS). STARTING AT THE TOP OF THE 8TH INNING AND CONTINUING EACH INNING THEREAFTER, THE LAST BATTER FROM THE PREVIOUS INNING IS A BASE RUNNER AT SECOND BASE WITH ONE OUT ASSESSED
OPEN INNINGS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6TH INNING (AND ALL OTHER INNINGS AFTERWARDS, OR THE LAST DECLARED INNING BY THE UMPIRE) - ONLY IF TIME PERMITS. OTHERWISE, FIVE RUNS MAXIMUM PER INNING • BOTH TEAM CAPTAINS' ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REQUESTING A GAME TIME CHECK TO THE UMPIRE - PRIOR TO THE START OF THE FIFTH INNING (AND THE START OF EACH INNING AFTERWARDS)
FORFEITED GAME:	A TEAM HAVING LESS THAN NINE PLAYERS PRESENT, AFTER THE TEN-MINUTE GRACE TIME HAS BEEN SERVED. THE SCORE OF THE GAME IS RECORDED AS 7-0, AND THE OFFENDING TEAM WILL FACE ADDITIONAL PENALTIES
OFFICIAL LEAGUE GAME BALL:	IS THE .40 C.O.R. 'MVP CRUSHER' OPTIC YELLOW BALL AND/OR THE .40 C.O.R. DEMARINI OPTIC YELLOW BALL
SPN CO-ED WALK RULE:	A MALE BATTER WALKED ON ANY PITCH COUNT (WITH AN ON-DECK FEMALE BATTER) IS AWARDED TWO BASES (THE FEMALE BATTER MUST BAT HER TURN). ALL OTHER SITUATIONS, THE BATTER IS AWARDED ONE BASE.
NO SMOKING OR DRINKING:	<p>NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE PLAYING FIELD (INCLUDING THE COACHES' BOXES, AND ANY FAIR/FOUL TERRITORY PLAYING AREAS). DRINKING NOT ALLOWED AT THE DIAMOND LOCATION (INCLUDING PARKING LOTS AND BLEACHERS).</p> <p>THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED IN ALL PARK LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF BURNABY.</p>
PERSONAL AND TEAM CONDUCT:	<p>CITYWIDE SPORTS IS NOT RESPONSIBLE (IN FULL OR IN PART) FOR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PLAYER(S) AND/OR TEAM(S) DETERMINED TO BE IN A VIOLATION OF CONDUCT • ANY LEGAL COSTS, FINES OR ANY OTHER CONVICTIONS ETC. WHICH MAY RESULT FROM ONE'S PARTICIPATION OR ATTENDANCE OF A LEAGUE OR NON-LEAGUE SANCTIONED EVENT/ACTIVITY

COURTESY RUNNER RULE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MAXIMUM OF THREE TIMES PER TEAM PER GAME (PROVIDED THE BATTER HAS SAFELY REACHED BASE) • ONLY PLAYERS LISTED ON THEIR TEAM'S LINE-UP CARD (EITHER AS A STARTER OR SUBSTITUTE) ARE ELIGIBLE • A COURTESY RUNNER MAY BE USED FOR A COURTESY RUNNER; MALE FOR MALE; FEMALE FOR FEMALE; OR A FEMALE FOR MALE • A TEAM CANNOT USE THE SAME COURTESY RUNNER MORE THAN ONCE IN A GAME
CO-ED PLAYING RATIO:	<p>CITYWIDE SPORTS PLAYS WITH A CO-ED PLAYING RATIO OF 6&4 – A GAME STARTING WITH A CO-ED PLAYING RATIO OTHER THAN 6&4 (i.e. 5&5): A MALE PLAYER MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR A FEMALE PLAYER, TO BRING THE CO-ED PLAYING RATIO TO 6&4. THE CO-ED PLAYING RATIO MAY NEVER EXCEED 6&4 (i.e. 8&2; 7&3; OR 9&1). STARTING PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED TO RE-ENTER THE GAME, AS LONG AS THEY ARE IN THEIR ORIGINAL BATTING POSITION (FOLLOWING THE RE-ENTRY AND SUBSTITUTION RULES). (FOR THIS SITUATION): A MALE BATTER SUBSTITUTING FOR A FEMALE BATTER WOULD BE ALLOWED, AS LONG AS THERE ARE NO MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE MALE BATTERS THROUGHOUT ANY PART OF THE BATTING ORDER (SUBSTITUTION/RE-ENTRY RULES ALWAYS APPLY).</p>
SLIDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NOT ALLOWED AT EITHER THE SCORING OR HOME PLATES • NO BASE RUNNER MAY INTENTIONALLY SLIDE, IN ORDER TO ATTEMPT TO INJURE ANOTHER PLAYER OR SLIDE IN AN AGGRESSIVE MANNER • A PLAYER WHO IS DETERMINED (IN THE DISCRETION OF THE UMPIRE) WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EJECTED FROM THE GAME, AND WILL FACE FURTHER LEAGUE DISCIPLINARY ACTION
ILLEGAL BATS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SPN AND CITYWIDE SPORTS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY PROBLEMS OF ANY NATURE CAUSED BY THE USE OF SUCH BATS AND/OR INCORRECTLY-LABELED BATS BY THE MANUFACTURER(S) • ALL SLO-PITCH PLAYERS ARE PUT ON NOTICE THAT THEY ARE PLAYING OR ATTENDING ANY GAME OR EVENT AT THEIR OWN RISK • SPN (ALONG WITH CITYWIDE SPORTS) FOLLOW THE LATEST A.S.A. (American Softball Association) BAT CERTIFICATION PROGRAM GUIDELINES • ALL SUSPENSIONS/DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS ARE PER SPN RULEBOOK GUIDELINES
LEGAL SHOES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MUST BE MADE WITH EITHER LEATHER OR CANVASS UPPERS (OR SIMILAR MATERIALS) • THE SOLES MAY HAVE SOFT OR HARD RUBBER CLEATS (DETACHABLE SOFT OR HARD RUBBER CLEATS ARE ALLOWED)
ILLEGAL SHOES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • INCLUDES METAL CLEATS, METAL SPIKES AND/OR METAL DETACHABLE CLEATS • PLAYERS DETERMINED TO BE IN USE OF ILLEGAL SHOES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY EJECTED FROM THE GAME (ALONG WITH THE TEAM COACH - NO OTHER EXCEPTIONS), AND WILL FACE FURTHER LEAGUE DISCIPLINARY ACTION
LEAGUE'S SPN INSURANCE COVERAGE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IS VALID ONLY AT OFFICIAL LEAGUE SANCTIONED GAMES AND EVENTS (REGULAR SEASON, PLAYOFF AND OTHERWISE) • THIS POLICY ONLY COVERS BASIC THIRD PARTY LIABILITY (EXAMPLE: A BATTER HITS A FOUL BALL, WHICH INJURES A PEDESTRIAN WALKING BY); AMBULANCE TRANSPORTATION COSTS; AND ANY MEDICAL SUPPLIES NEEDED TO TREAT THE INJURY AT A HOSPITAL • AN INJURY MUST BE REPORTED NO LATER THAN 24 HOURS AFTER THE TIME OF INCIDENT TO THE LEAGUE PRESIDENT • ALL REGISTERED PLAYERS PLAYING IN CITYWIDE SPORTS EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES MUST HAVE THEIR OWN PERSONAL MEDICAL AND DENTAL INSURANCE, AND LOSS OF INCOME (EXTENDED AND COMPREHENSIVE) INSURANCE • THE PERSON WHO SUBMITS A CLAIM IS 100% RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING ALL ASSOCIATED INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLES AND/OR COSTS • IF ALCOHOL AND/OR NARCOTICS ARE DETERMINED TO BE A CONTRIBUTING FACTOR IN AN INCIDENT, SPN AND THE INSURANCE UNDERWRITER (THEREFORE) MAY DENY THE CLAIM
PARKING OF VEHICLES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ALL VEHICLES SHOULD BE PARKED IN AREAS AWAY FROM THE PLAYING AREA, TO MINIMIZE ANY POTENTIAL DAMAGE (WHICH COULD RESULT FROM A BATTED OR THROWN BALL OR OTHER AIRBORNE EQUIPMENT) • VEHICLE DAMAGE IS COVERED UNDER THE LEAGUE'S SPN INSURANCE POLICY (YOU ARE PARKING AT YOUR OWN RISK), BUT THE INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLES ARE THE ENTIRE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CLAIMANT • VEHICLES PARKED IN AREAS INDICATED AS 'NO PARKING' ARE SUBJECT TO FINES AND/OR TOWING PER BUSINESS/HOME OWNER AND/OR CITY
VALUABLE ITEMS:	<p>FOR MINIMIZING AND REDUCING THEFT AND/OR VANDALISM POSSIBILITIES, ALL VISIBLE AND VALUABLE ITEMS INSIDE YOUR OWN PERSONAL VEHICLE SHOULD BE HIDDEN FROM VIEW</p>

PETS AND/OR CHILDREN:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PERSONS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEHAVIOR, ACTIONS OR INCIDENTS CAUSED BY, OR INVOLVING EITHER THEIR OWN PETS AND/OR CHILDREN • ALL PETS (DOGS, ETC.)
